Acton region SADC (Community Futures Development Corporation CFDC)	INVESTMENT FUND \$5,000 to \$150,000 loan	Financial contribution to supplement the funding of business projects, regardless of their sector and stage of development, in order to support job creation in the territory covered by the CIDC in the Acton region.
EDC (Economic Development Canada)	BUSINESS AND REGIONAL GROWTH, COMMUNITY DIVERSIFICATION \$0-\$500,000 loan Interest-free 24-month moratorium	Loans given to SMEs in the industrial or tertiary structuring sector to supplement project funding, namely with regard to improving productivity, developing products and marketing internationally.
Emploi Québec	AID FOR JOB CREATION Subsidy, 25% to 50% of eligible costs	Financial assistant for training or human resources management consulting, for all businesses planning a project that will significantly impact employment in the Acton region or following a large investment. OR All businesses that create 50 new full-time, long-term jobs within a 24 month period.
Investissement Québec	IMMIGRANT INVESTOR Non-refundable contribution \$40,000 to \$250,000	Financial assistance for SMEs working in the following sectors: manufacturing, new economy, high value-added information technology, waste recycling, recovery and processing, tourism, environmental rehabilitation, centralized call centre and specialized horticulture. No fees to pay.
	LOAN GUARANTEE OR LOAN Minimum \$50,000	The sectors of ecological funding, interim tax credit funding, productivity improvement, exportation, working capital, innovation, strategic alliance or succession.
MDEIE	LENDING PROGRAMS OR NON-REFUNDABLE CONTRIBUTIONS For \$250,000 to \$5,000,000 projects	For SMEs working in the manufacturing sector, but also environmental services, client contact centres, software release and private research centres.
	FONDS D'AIDE AUX MUNICIPALITÉS MONOINDUSTRIELLES (assistance funds for single-industry municipalities) Subsidy, up to 50% of the total cost for private businesses and 70% of the total cost for NPOs	All businesses planning a development project that will positively impact the Acton RCM's economic structure, particularly projects in the manufacturing and tertiary technology sectors, namely the ACCORD Montérégie niches.
MAMROT	FONDS DE SOUTIEN AUX TERRITOIRES EN DIFFICULTÉ (support funds for territories in difficulty) Subsidy, 10% of the total cost must be provided by the area	All projects stemming from the strategic directions of the action plan established by the Acton RCM.
